What to Bring

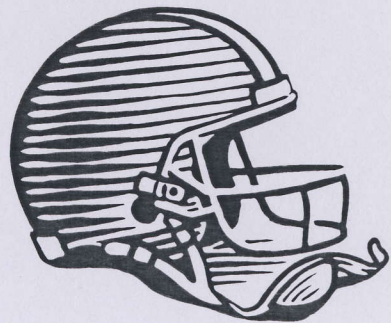

Camp Objectives: To provide young athletes with the opportunity to develop fundamental football skills in a well-supervised, organized, and enthusiastic environment. Our goal is to give each participant the finest football instruction possible in an atmosphere of fun.

Instruction will be based on the objective to ensure each camper gains knowledge and skill through lectures, demonstrations, and drill sessions on all aspects of football.

Camp Benefits: Tuition includes:

Campers will learn the Wellington High School offensive and defensive terminology, techniques, and schemes. There will be sessions of inside run, skelly, and team.

Practice in all phases of football: offense, defense, and kicking.

Location: High School practice field located directly west of the new high school.

Eligible Students: All students entering grades 7th & 8th for the 2010 - 2011 school year.

Date and Time: Wednesday, August 4 and Thursday, August 5. On Wednesday, August 4, at 6:00 p.m. there will be a brief meeting with all the parents and campers on the guidelines of the camp. Campers should arrive at the high school practice field at 6:00 p.m. and should be picked up at 8:30 p.m. each evening.

Tuition/Payment: The fee for each summer camper is \$30. Early registrations are preferred. Payment will also be accepted upon arrival of the first day of camp. Make checks payable to Middle School Football Camp. (No refunds will be given once the camp has started on August 4.)

Insurance: The camp is a non-contact camp. There will be no pads worn. Most importantly, your child's health and safety will be our first and foremost concern at all times. Accidental Medical Insurance for each camper is provided at no extra charge. The maximum aid by the secondary policy is \$25,000.
