The first college or university in the region to issue laptops to all entering new students, Southwestern is also the first to go wireless—take your Dell laptop to virtually any area on campus (your study group or your room) and log on. You also can listen to many campus events live via the Web.

Facilities

It isn't just the most up-to-date classrooms, although we've got those. Our improvements (including an immediate emergency notification system) get you right where you live. Here are some examples:

- ◆ Our library, remodeled in the summer of 2008 to be a center of the academic community.
- ◆ Sutton Hall (remodeled in 2006) reopened with upgraded suite-style living space.
- ◆ Beech Science Center and Mabee Laboratory Complex where science meets state-of-the-art.
- ◆ The newly-rebuilt 77 Steps and Mound, which have retained the tradition and emotion that have made them The Heart of the Hill.
- ◆ A hilly, wooded campus that defies the stereotype of Kansas (and will boast 125 new trees soon)

Academic Excellence

We believe in making education relevant to the lives our students live now, and will live in the future. That's why we started the Green Team, a cross-disciplinary service learning program that focuses on achieving a sustainable lifestyle. We also offer fifth-year master's programs that allow students to complete graduate degrees in business administration or leadership. And we're the only school in Kansas officially designated a College of Access and Opportunity by the Center for Student Opportunity.

Financial Aid

We work hard to make quality education affordable to anyone—99% of our entering freshmen receive financial aid from Southwestern College.

Student Athletes

Our athletes are students first, but they shine in competition, too. Since 1981 Southwestern has had more than 155 academic all-Americans in its 15 varsity sports. During 2007-08 Southwestern won five of the 13 Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference championships—men's golf, men's cross-country (28 consecutive titles), women's cross-country, and men's and women's track. Our women's golf, basketball, and tennis teams qualified for national competition. We play hard, we study hard, we win.

Student Activities

Southwestern offers great opportunities to participate in the same activities you loved in high school. You can be part of music, theatre, student government, campus ministry, and other squads without majoring in them, if that's what you choose. Students in Free Enterprise, Leadership Southwestern, and Discipleship Southwestern are nationally recognized for their excellence, and active student organizations make for a lively academic, social, and spiritual life on campus.

Future

Since 1885 Southwestern College's tradition of excellence has been building. Just a few years ago the *Builders of Excellence* campaign far surpassed its \$24 million goal by raising more than \$26 million. Now the *Great Performances* campaign is focusing on athletics and the performing arts, with an ambitious goal of upgraded facilities, scholarships, and program support.
