Health & Safety Guidelines

- Mask Policy Masks are required at all times while inside all USD 264 buildings. This includes all participants (Workers/Teams/Cheerleaders/Dance/Band).
- Players/Coaches are to wear masks on the bench.
- Temperature checks will be administered before purchasing a ticket. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 and above will not be permitted entry.
- Each team is responsible for its own hand sanitizer and its own med-kit.
- Teams will be provided with 6 warm-up balls but must use the same warm-up balls during the competition.
- Pregame and postgame handshakes are not to be used. Teams will find an alternate way to show respect/gratitude to the opposing team and officials.
- Spectators should sit as family/common groups. Uncommon family groups should try to maintain 6' of social distancing.
- Please bring exact change when possible to limit exchange between patrons and workers.
- Only essential personnel (players, coaches, officials, administrators and event workers) are allowed on the court during a contest.
- At the conclusion of the event please exit the facilities. Congregating near the locker rooms, in the stands, or on the court is not permitted.
- Programs will be accessed electronically via QR codes. A hard copy program will be available the following day of an event upon request.
- After competition, players will wash their hands, wear face masks and practice social distancing.
- Cheerleaders are permitted and will cheer in the East end of the gym. All Cheerleaders must comply with KSHSAA rules relating with Covid-19.
- Opposing players that are not playing must sit on the bleachers opposite of their bench
