CHS participants will be issued FOUR (4) color coded wristbands per event to distribute at their discretion. A limited number of wristbands will be available for CHS student body. Spectators must wear the event specific wristband on wrist in order to purchase tickets at the event and enter the gymnasium. Wristbands must be worn throughout the event.

The visiting team will receive TWENTY-FIVE (25) wristbands. Spectators must wear the event specific wristband on wrist in order to purchase tickets at the event and enter the gymnasium.

CONCESSIONS: We will have a small concession stand in the Commons Area.

HOSPITALITY: We will have a hospitality room for coaches, officials, and administrators.

VOLLEYBALLS: Schools will provide their own volleyballs for warm-up. The host school will provide ball carts for use. Clean game balls will be rotated into the match at the end of each game/set.

TOWELS: Towels will not be provided.

LOCKER ROOMS: A locker room will not be available, please come dressed and ready to play.

MATCHES: All matches will be best 2 out of 3 games. The first two games will be played to 25 with no cap. ***If a 3rd game is necessary, it will be played to 15 points (win by 2).***

AWARDS: Team awards will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams.

BRACKET: The format for the freshman tournament will be two pools of 4 teams each. The top two teams from each pool will advance to the championship round.

OFFICIALS: *Assigned by the GWOA.* Officials will arrive onsite in their officiating attire; a locker room will not be provided. A separate bathroom will be provided for officials. Officials should bring their own food and water container **CLEARLY MARKED**. Officials may but are not required to wear a mask while working but will wear a mask between matches. Officials will not be expected to monitor physical distancing; each person is responsible.

Health & Safety Guidelines

- Mask Policy - Masks are required at all times while inside all USD 264 buildings.
- Temperature checks will be administered before purchasing a ticket. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 and above will not be permitted entry.
- Spectators should sit as family/common groups. Uncommon family groups should try to maintain 6' of social distancing.
- Please bring exact change when possible to limit exchange between patrons and workers.
- If you leave the facility you will not be allowed to re-enter.
- Only essential personnel (players, coaches, officials, administrators and event workers) are allowed on the court during a contest.
- At the conclusion of the event please exit the facilities. Congregating near the locker rooms, in the stands, or on the court is not permitted.
- Programs will be accessed electronically via QR codes. A hard copy program will be available the following day of an event upon request.
- Clearwater will be responsible for cleaning score table, team benches, and officials stand between matches.
- Schools will provide their own volleyballs for warm-up. The host school will provide ball carts for use. Clean game balls will be rotated into the match at the end of each game/set.
- Players should practice social distancing as often as possible.
- After competition, players will wash their hands, wear face masks and practice social distancing.
- No pre-game and post-game handshakes/high-fives/fist bumps.
- Each team is responsible for its own hand sanitizer and its own med kit.

- Masks will be worn during the pre-match conference (R1, R2 and team coaches). Captains will not attend.
- Players and team personnel on the team bench should practice social distancing.
- Only athletes will touch the balls. Players will retrieve stray balls. Ball should be set on the floor during a timeout.
- A sanitized back up ball should be available at the score table (someone needs to be designated to sanitize the ball(s).
- Players would need to use hand sanitizer before entering and when exiting the court during substitutions or with libero; no hand touching allowed during substitutions (sanitizer could be set up on a chair at end of bench.)
- Each school is responsible to bring towels to wipe up sweat off the floor.
- Players should avoid huddles after each dead ball. Officials will issue delay of game if prolonged.
- Suspend the protocol of teams switching benches between sets. In the event there is a clear and distinct disadvantage, teams may switch sides, observing all social distancing protocols. Officials will determine if a disadvantage is present.
- No pre- or post-game handshakes will take place.
