VISITOR FILMING: Camera personnel may either be inside the pressbox, or go up on top of the pressbox in the fenced area.

OFFICIALS: Officials have been assigned by the GWOA. Officials should park in the large parking lot east of the Intermediate Center (parking lot off of Ross St.).
