### **Back to School Time**

# **School Redesign**

Fourth and fifth graders at Kennedy, and 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders at WHS will be involved in school redesign this year. In the redesign classrooms, students will continue to have lessons taught by licensed teachers every day, but they'll also be able to work digitally on laptops each day. Additionally, students involved in school redesign will be working on real-world project based learning. Please visit the district website for more information on school redesign. The district's expansion of laptops for students will make digital learning possible for all students.

## One to One Laptop Program

Last year, WMS began a one to one laptop program and every student was assigned their very own laptop. This year, the program is expanding to the high school, and the district is also expanding access to laptops for most of our elementary students. Expanded access to technology will allow for greater personalized learning for all students. Additionally, increased access to technology will allow district schools to place more emphasis on STEM activities.

#### STEM

Science, technology, engineering, and mathematic or (STEM) will continue to be emphasized in USD 353. Increasingly, the jobs waiting for our students will require more knowledge in the STEM areas. This past year we saw elementary students in some schools building computers, writing code, and working with robotics. All schools will see a greater emphasis in this area.
