Games will be played at Circle High School (905 Main St, Towanda, KS).

Bus Parking: Park buses and unload athletes on the north side of the auxiliary gym.

Teams must provide their own balls and ball carts for warm-ups.

Order of Matches:

- 5:00 PM** (West) Circle vs Wellington
(East) Andale vs McPherson
- 6:00 PM** (West) Circle vs Andale
(East) McPherson vs Wellington
- 7:00 PM** (West) Circle vs McPherson
(East) Andale vs Wellington

Warm-up will be 20 min before a teams first match, 10 min thereafter.

COVID Guidelines Players & Coaches:

- Players and coaches should wear masks upon arrival, in the locker room and on sidelines when not actively participating.
- Home and visiting teams should complete COVID screening prior to arriving (temp checks, hand sanitizer, health screening questions, etc.)
- Teams are encouraged to come dressed.
- Locker room use should be limited (small groups, meet outside of the locker room, etc.).

Guidelines for Event Spectators at USD 375 Events:

- Spectators will be limited to 2 per participant with a maximum of 25% venue capacity.
- Each participant will get an event specific wristband that they will be responsible to distribute to their two spectators. (participants include players, coaches, managers, cheer, and other essential personnel)
- spectators must wear the event specific wristband **on their wrist** in order to purchase their ticket at the event and enter the venue, wristbands must be worn during the event.
 - Adults: \$6.00 Students: \$4.00
- All passes will be suspended until spectator restrictions are lifted
 - This includes staff ID, senior citizen, complementary and league passes.
- Masks are required all times while inside USD 375 buildings.
- Spectators should sit as family units, and social distance.
- Spectators will not be allowed near participant groups, or on fields/courts. Only essential personnel will be allowed near participants groups.
- All these spectator guidelines are subject to change based on local conditions.
