7 HOURS OF LEARNING JUST LIKE A TRADITIONAL SCHOOL DAY!!!

- ★ 3 hours of Face-to-Face time (AM GROUP: 8:00-11:00 am & PM GROUP: 12:40-3:40 pm)
 - Direct Instruction
 - Hands-On Learning
 - Independent Work
 - Intervention Time (based on FastBridge Testing)
 - Small Group Skills Work (with social distancing)
 - Specials (PE &/OR Music)
- ★ 4 hours of Remote Learning (AM Group 11:40 am 3:40 pm & PM GROUP: 8:00 am 12:00 pm)
 - Google Classroom Assignments
 - Google Meets
 - Workbooks (Math, Reading, Writing, etc.)
 - Classroom packets and resources
 - o Online Learning Websites (Dreambox, RAZ Kids, Reflex, etc.)
 - o Project Based Learning Assignments
 - Enrichment
 - Art
 - Brain Breaks
 - And more...it will vary by grade level!!!

First Few Weeks during student REMOTE time - Chromebooks WILL NOT be at home. Students will be using the Chromebooks at school to complete Fastbridge Testing. Teachers will also be training students on how to successfully use Google Classroom as the online platform for their remote learning time. For the first few weeks, paper resources will be sent home with kids so they can successfully complete learning checklist items for the week! The <u>parents and students</u> WILL BE required to sign a checklist log recognizing the completion of the checklist items for the week during the time that students do not have their Chromebooks.

Once Chromebooks Go Home - Students will use their Chromebooks to complete online assignments and activities through Google Classroom. They will also be doing check-ins through Google Meet with an IKE staff member (assigned Google Meet times will be communicated by the classroom teacher...TBD). This will also serve as the "remote attendance" and therefore a checklist log WILL NOT have to be signed by the student and parent once Chromebooks go home.

- Not applicable to Kindergarten because they will not take Chromebooks home until the 2nd 9-weeks!
- * Remote Learning Responsibilities WILL BE communicated to you and your child by the classroom teacher. The assignments and activities will vary by grade level.
