EVENT: KSHSAA Girls Division II Sub-State I Wrestling Tournament

TIME / DATE: 3:00pm – Friday, February 19, 2021

LOCATION: Ellis High School, 1706 S. Monroe St., Ellis, KS 67637

TEAMS: We have 90 wrestlers representing 36 schools this weekend. Here is a breakdown of the participating schools and which KSHSAA District they were representing. The Districts will be used to assign locker rooms (see “Locker Rooms” section).

DISTRICT #1: Atwood-Rawlins County (1), Colby (2), Ellis (5), Hoisington (5), Hoxie (1), Norton Community (1), Oakley (3), Phillipsburg (1), Plainville (3), Smith Center (1), and WaKeeney-Trego Community (1)

DISTRICT #2: Cimarron (2), Lakin (2), Langdon-Fairfield (1), Larned (2), Nickerson (3), and Pratt (7)

DISTRICT #3: Augusta (2), Burden-Central (1), Douglass (5), El Dorado (1), Leon-Bluestem (1), Mulvane (5), Rose Hill (1), Towanda-Circle (2), Wellington (6), and Winfield (1),

DISTRICT #4: Abilene (2), Brookville-Ell Saline (1), Buhler (1), Cottonwood Falls-Chase County (4), Council Grove (4), Lindsborg-Smoky Valley (3), Lyons (3), McPherson (6), and Whitewater-Remington (1)

PARKING: Buses and school vehicles may drop teams off in front of the high school. Parking will be available in the north lot. Buses should avoid using the south lot. Spectators may park in the north lot, south lot, or along Monroe Street.

SEEDING MEETING: There will not be a seeding meeting. Brackets are set from the Regional qualifying tournaments.

ENTRY INFO: The top 4 placers from Regional #1 and #2 will be placed in an 8-person bracket by KSHSAA. Please be sure to send KSHSAA form WR-SSG to dschoenthaler@usd388.com by 12:00pm on Wednesday, February 17.

- PASS GATE:** Please email names of wrestlers, coaches, managers, attending administrators, and bus drivers if applicable to dschoenthaler@usd388.com by 8:00am on Friday, February 19.
- ADMISSIONS:** We have been approved to allow schools 4 tickets per qualifying wrestler for this event in order for us to remain at an appropriate capacity level. This format is the same that will be used by the State Tournaments next weekend, except they will allow 7 tickets per qualifying wrestler. Tickets vouchers for this Friday will be emailed to school athletic directors on Tuesday, February 16. You will need to print out the tickets with the appropriate serial numbers and distribute them as you deem appropriate. Ticket vouchers must be presented with the KSHSAA Sub-State admission fee of \$8 to enter. Admissions table will open at 2:00pm. Only KSHSAA passes are accepted for this event.
- COMPETITION:** We will be using Track Wrestling (trackwrestling.com) to run the live scoring for this event. We will use 2 mats for each round. We have 146 matches scheduled. All front side matches will be 2-2-2 and all consolation matches will be 1-2-2. All KSHSAA Wrestling rules will apply to this event.
- SCHEDULE:** We will allow teams to enter our facility at 12:00pm. We will have scales available to check weight at that time and locker rooms will be available. Classes and lunches are in session at EHS until 12:30pm on Friday. Teams entering the building before that time will need to stay in the gym/locker room area. We will conduct weigh-ins and skin checks at 1:00pm. Wrestling will begin at 3:00pm.
- Round 1 – Quarterfinals
 - Round 2 – Semifinals / 1st Rd. Consolation
 - *Short break to clean mats.
 - Round 3 – Consolation Semifinals
 - Round 4 – Finals (5th, 3rd, and 1st place matches)
- LOCKER ROOMS:** Locker rooms will be assigned to each school. We have designated our 4 locker rooms for the 4 KSHSAA Districts (see “Teams” section). Schools who participated in District #1 will be assigned the NE Locker Room. Schools who participated in District #2 will be assigned the SE Locker Room. Schools who participated in District #3 will be assigned the SW Locker Room. Schools who participated in District #4 will be assigned the NW Locker Room. The Officials’ Locker Room is located down the SW ramp of the gym. Please note that schools will be sharing locker rooms and they will be crowded. We will not supply towels for teams so you are asked to bring your own. Ellis High School is not responsible for lost or stolen items so please secure any and all valuables.
- MAT AREA:** A maximum of 2 team personnel (coaches and/or non-participating contestants) are permitted on chairs at the end of the mat. Coaches, please help maintain compliance to this rule.
- AWARDS:** Medals will be given to the top 4 finishers in each weight class. The Sub-State Tournament team champion will receive a plaque. We will wrestle out to sixth place. We will present awards during the finals shortly after the completion of all matches in the weight class.
