Please take note of the following:

- When you arrive, please use the west entrance to Cheney High School. Buses are asked to park in the street west of the high school parking lot.
- Fans should not arrive before 1:00pm for the afternoon session. We want to allow the first session to exit before new fans arrive.
- Bring your own practice balls, a cart will be provided. Please bring your own towels. We prefer that
 you come dressed, but locker rooms are available for teams if necessary. You are expected to secure
 your own valuables.
- The home team for each match will be asked to provide a libero tracker. Please have someone that can volunteer for this position at the scorer's table.
- There will be no awards this year.
- Admission is \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students (K-12). Players and personnel listed on pass
 gate will be admitted without charge. No passes will be accepted. Digital ticketing for fans will be
 used with details later in the document.
- Teams are asked to leave when your matches are complete. Gatherings with family can take place outside.
- Concessions will be available throughout the day. Prepackaged hospitality will be provided for coaches, officials, tournament workers and school officials.

VOLLEYBALL COVID GUIDELINES

- Visiting teams are to temp check players before traveling.
- All spectators will be temp checked and required to wear a mask inside the building at all times. Spectators are to social distance in the bleachers and asked to sit with their family unit.
- When a team is finished playing for the day, the team and fans are asked to leave the building.
- Cleaning supplies will be available to clean the net, stand, benches and balls.
- Teams are to bring their own warmup balls. A cart will be provided.
- Coaches and players are to wear masks on the bench.
- Players are to retrieve all stray balls. A backup game ball will be available at the table.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for players substituting in and out of games.
- Pregame and postgame handshakes are not to be used. Teams will find an alternate way to show respect/gratitude to the opposing team and officials.

DIGITAL TICKETING

Cheney events are operating at 25% capacity and using digital tickets as a spectator control method for Varsity events.

Tickets for visitors can be purchased in advance at www.usd268.org (Tickets link at top).

Tickets will go on sale 9/21 at 7:00am and close at 6:00pm on 9/25. Visitors will have a passcode shared with you. There are 60 tickets available for each visiting team. On Saturday, any available tickets will be first come, first served until we reach capacity.

The tickets will be emailed to the fan and can be redeemed via phone or printed ticket.

For fans that would rather not use the digital tickets, gates open one hour prior to the event and they are first come, first served until we reach capacity.

For fans that pay with cash, we ask for exact change only, to reduce the risk of spreading illness.
