Start Time:

Boys Regional Weigh-ins begin at 1:00pm and the first round begins at 3:00pm. on Friday, February 12th.
Girls Regional Weigh-ins begin at 10:00am and the first round begins at 12:00pm on Saturday, February 13th.
All wrestlers will have to weigh in full uniform in our auxiliary gym.

Entry Forms and Passgate:

Regional entries are due by noon on February 10, 2021 (WR-RB is for boys and WR-RG is for girls).

Seeding Procedures:

No seeding meeting: Brackets are set from the first qualifying tournament.

Officials: Assigned by KSHSAA

Passgate: Please complete the enclosed roster and pass gate information. Return no no later than noon on Wednesday, February 10th, 2021.

Pass Gate:

The pass gate will be located in the lower commons. Buses may unload on the south side of the high school. Please park your buses/vans on the south side of the high school.

Locker Rooms:

Locker rooms will be assigned. Your team name will be located outside the locker room. We have four locker rooms.

Tickets and Fan Capacity for 2021:

1. Regional = \$7.00 per ticket (all sold tickets are the same price).
2. Capacity limitations are set at no more than four fans per participant. A participant is a wrestler, coach, school manager, administrator.
3. Due to spectator limitations, we are asking teams to not bring their cheerleaders.
4. Masks are required of all participants and fans. Wrestlers may wrestle without masks but are required to wear them at all other times. Officials will adhere to this same requirement.

Awards:

1. The awards will include four medals for each weight class and a team plaque for the tournament champion.
2. The top four (4) wrestlers in each weight class will receive a medal. In addition, the team champion will receive a plaque.
3. All brackets will wrestle out to 6 places.

Mats:

No more than two mats will be used for this tournament.

Coaches:

1. During tournament competition, "a maximum of two team personnel" (coaches and/or non-participating contestants) will be permitted on chairs at the edge of the mat... (NO EXCEPTIONS THIS YEAR)
2. OFFICIALS, the rule is clear and coaches know the rule, therefore, hold them accountable to this rule for the safety of the competitors that are on the mat and for the ability to maintain a controlled environment mat side. It is the responsibility of all coaches to maintain compliance to this rule and not place your responsibility in the hands of the official. Likewise, it is important that all officials are consistent in addressing this issue in fairness to every wrestler and school as well as out of respect to other officials who are enforcing the rules.

Concessions:

We will not have concessions. We ask that you please keep your coolers in the assigned area in our auxiliary gym.

We will not have a hospitality room. We will have bottled water.

COVID Guidelines Players & Coaches:

- Players and coaches should wear masks upon arrival, in the locker room and when not actively participating.

Guidelines for Event Spectators at USD 375 Events:

- Circle High School will allow for attendance of up to four spectators per participant(s) family as allowed by the school board of education and Butler County Health department. Restrictions with a maximum of 25% venue capacity.
- A pass gate will have each participant with their four spectators listed. AD's please provide an updated pass list by Wednesday at noon prior to the event.
- Admission will be Adults: \$7.00 and \$7.00 for K-12.
- Masks are required all times while inside USD 375 buildings.
 - The face covering should be worn in the manner it is intended to be worn-covering the mouth and nose.
- Spectators should sit as family cohorts and social distance. • Spectators will not be allowed near any participant groups. • Only essential personnel are allowed on the court near participant groups
- All these spectator guidelines are subject to change based on local conditions.
