## Rossville Jr Sr High Fall/Winter Athletics Protocol

# (Very subject to change)

The goal of these guidelines are to minimize risk to the student athletes and fans and maximize the amount of participation time our student athletes see and our fans get to watch. Properly worn masks are a must when indoors and outside when social distancing cannot be achieved. If the fans cannot self-regulate we may be required to not allow fan attendance. Please remember we are doing this for our kids.

## **General Information:**

- Mask required for entry for any event.
- Spectators are asked to social distance and sit in family cohorts where possible in their specific sections.
- Temperature will be taken for all spectators at indoor events.
- Spectators with temperature above 100.4 or flu like symptoms will not allowed to enter.
- Rossville athletes will have temperature checked before they get on the bus for away competitions. We ask visiting teams do the same.
- Visiting teams are strongly encouraged to show up dressed to play, but locker rooms will be available upon request.
- We will live stream as many of our games as possible on either our you tube channel or our Dawg Feed Facebook pages. We also have the Pixellot system from NFHS which is available by a minor subscription.

- Spectators will not be allowed near participant groups or on the field or courts. Only essential personnel will be allowed near participant groups.
- All forms of tailgating will not be permitted until further notice.
- Concessions may be available at events, but will all be prepackaged.

## Wrestling:

- 1 fans per athlete, Max. May be subject to no spectators
- Temperatures will be taken up on entry, teams should take temperatures before getting on the bus.
- Mask required by all fans to be worn at all times- please wear it correctly.
- Coaches and athletes masks are to be worn at all times with the exception of when wrestling.
- Please stay socially distanced or sit in family cohorts.
- Visiting team fans will sit in separate sections in the bleachers.
- Home team fans will sit in separate sections in the bleachers.
- Concessions, if offered, will be all prepackaged items.
- Mats will be cleaned or fogged periodically.
- KSHSAA Wrestling guidelines will be followed closely

Basketball:

- Masks will be required to be worn while in the building.
- Temperature will be taken prior to entry
- 160 fans will be allowed in the main gym and 80 in the new gym.

The bleachers will be divided into home and visitor sections.

- Wrist bands will be distributed and you must have a wrist band to pay admission and enter.
- Please sit in family cohorts or social distance.
- Visiting team is asked to bring their own warm up balls.
- Concessions will be prepackaged.
- Visiting teams are asked to clean their bench area before leaving
