## **Facilities:**

- 1. Our track and runway surfaces are rubberized. Spikes should be no longer than ¼".
- 2. The shot put and discus rings are concrete.
- 3. Athletes will not be allowed to sit on turf areas of the field. Please set up your team camp in the bleachers, not on the field.

## Other Guidelines:

- 1. Athletes may be entered in four events. Each school will be allowed four entries per division. Two relay entries per school for each division.
- 2. All scratches and changes will be made by the coaches. No additions or substitutions will be allowed after the coaches meeting.

- 3. All athletes in the throwing and horizontal jumping events will be given 4 attempts, with no preliminaries.
- 4. All running events will be run as finals against time.
- 5. One false start will be charged to the field. The second false start will disqualify the runner.
- 6. All athletes in throwing and horizontal jumping events will be given four attempts, and they will be run as finals with no prelims.
