Who can take DE? Students who have completed their eighth grade year of school and who will be 14 years of age by May 31, 2017 but not yet 21 years of age by September 1, 2017.

When is DE? Students will be assigned to either a 7:45 - 9:45 AM class or a 10:00 AM - 12:00 class. Students will also be assigned several 1 hour 40 Minute driving blocks during the session. These driving assignments will be made by the driving instructor. In order to pass the course, students may not miss more than 3 days of the session. Students successfully completing the program will be given ½ of a credit toward graduation. The course will be Pass - Fail, with students expected to complete all instructional Modules at the stated mastery percentage.
