- Classroom Packets and Resources
- Online Learning Websites (Dreambox, RAZ Kids, Reflex, etc.)

- Brain Breaks
- And more...*(It will vary by grade-level)*

First Two Weeks of School (during student REMOTE time) - Chromebooks WILL NOT be at home. Students will be using the Chromebooks at school to complete Fastbridge Testing. Teachers will also be training students on how to successfully use Google Classroom, as the online platform for their remote learning time. For the first few weeks of the school year, paper resources will be sent home with students, so they can successfully complete learning checklist items for the week. BOTH **parents and students** WILL BE required to sign a checklist log recognizing the completion of the checklist items for the week during the time that students do not have their Chromebooks.

Once Chromebooks Go Home (during student REMOTE time) - Students will use their Chromebooks to complete online assignments and activities through Google Classroom. They will also be doing check-ins through Google Meet with a Washington staff member (designed Google Meet times will be communicated by the classroom teacher). This will also serve as the “remote attendance” and therefore a checklist log WILL NOT have to be signed by the parent and student once Chromebooks go home. ***Kdg students will not take Chromebooks home until the second 9-weeks of school.***

Remote Learning Responsibilities WILL BE communicated to parents and students, by the classroom teacher. The assignments and activities will vary by grade-level.
