Wall of Crusader Recognition

Purpose

To honor a culture and tradition of excellence and high achievement by recognition of outstanding Wellington High School Alumni and contributors

To inspire current and future Crusaders to lead their lives in a way that will perpetuate the standards of excellence and high achievement the honorees have set forth.

Eligibility Requirements

A nominee may be eligible in one of two categories.

- 1. As a graduate of Wellington Senior High School.
 - A. Nominees must have graduated at least 10 years prior to their nomination.
 - B. Nominees must have achieved a high level of success as a professional in arts, science, industry, military or athletics, or as a volunteer in service of their country or state or community.
 - C. The nominee may or may not live in Wellington currently. May also be deceased.
 - D. Nominees will not be judged solely on their achievements while a student at WHS but also by their achievements after graduation
- 2. As a contributor of service to Wellington Sr. High School
 - A. This is for a nominee who is not a graduate of Wellington Senior High School.
 - B. This category may include administrators, teachers, WHS staff, parents or community members. May also be deceased.
 - C. Nominees must have contributed a minimum of 10 years of service to WHS.
 - D. Nominees must have donated unselfishly an extraordinary amount of time and or money in a way that has had positive impact on WHS and it students.
 - E. Nominees who were employees of USD 353 Wellington must be retired or no longer working for USD353.

Nominees will not be discriminated against based on race, creed, religion, sex, nationality, disability, economic or marital status.

Selection Committee

The selection committee consists of one member of the WHS faculty, two students, and three community members who are WHS alumni or former staff. Previous winners of the award are also eligible to vote.

Each year the committee will review all recent and previously submitted nomination forms.

Crusader Wall of Fame nominations are accepted on an ongoing basis. Honorees for the Wall of Fame are selected and notified in February. Presentation of Crusader Wall of Fame Inductees is made yearly at Crusader Class Night in May. A maximum of four or a minimum of one honoree will be selected each year.

The forms for nominees not selected will be saved on file and will be reviewed and reconsidered each subsequent year. (Nominations can also be resubmitted or updated at any time)

The committee reserves the right to disqualify any nominee or recipient who does not maintain the high standards of excellence and citizenship in the spirit that this award intended to represent.
